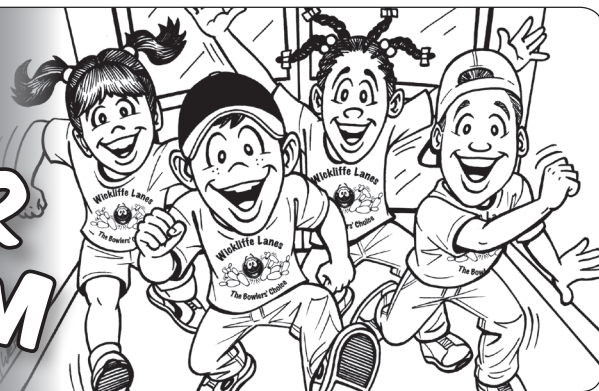


WICKLIFFE LANES SATURDAY JUNIOR BOWLING PROGRAM

* Bowlers participating in high school bowling can still bowl in the junior program. They simply will not be able to participate in the program for the 8 weeks during the high school season. Bowlers will not need to pay for the weeks that they don't participate in because of high school bowling.

NEW FOR 2011

We are adding two additional practice times for all of the junior bowlers to come in and practice and get additional coaching at no additional charge. We will have additional coaches available every Saturday from 9:00 am to 10:00 am and on Tuesdays from 4:00 pm to 5:30 pm. We encourage all of the kids to come in during those additional times to get more instruction and practice at no additional cost. Baseball players don't only play games, they have practices and bowling should be practiced too.

JUNIOR LEAGUES

Bowling is a great way for kids to have fun with their friends while building self-esteem and learning the importance of teamwork. Unlike other sports, in bowling everybody gets to compete. Nobody sits on the bench. All junior leagues are handicap so bowlers of all skill level can compete against each other on a level playing field. We are proud to say that we have over 400 kids annually in our junior program.

ADDITIONAL PRACTICE TIMES

We would like our Junior bowlers to get the most out of their league bowling experience. Football teams don't just only play in games, they have more practices then games. For this reason we have set aside 1 hour on Saturday morning and 1½ hours on Tuesday afternoon for the league bowlers to come in and practice and get additional coaching. This will be free of charge and we encourage all of the kids to try to take advantage of these times.

HIGH SCHOOL BOWLING

High School bowling is very popular and Northeast Ohio has some of the best bowling teams in the state. During the High School bowling season bowlers are not eligible to compete in the USBC sanction leagues because of current rules. Bowlers can participate in the program up until high school bowling starts and then start back once the high school bowling season is over. Bowlers will not have to pay for the weeks they miss due to high school bowling.

USBC BENEFITS

All junior bowlers will be required to pay a \$10.00 USBC fee. The United States Bowling Congress will be giving every junior bowler a bowling jersey — newly redesigned for 2011. Bowlers will also receive special achievement awards. All bowlers will also receive 4 issues of US Youth bowler delivered to their house. The USBC also certifies all bowlers averages so that they may compete in scholarship tournaments such as the Pepsi tournament that takes place every fall.

ADULT JUNIOR TOURNAMENT

Wickliffe Lanes 36th Annual Adult Junior Tournament will be taking place in January of 2012. We will be awarding a total of \$2,500.00 in scholarship money to the junior bowlers that bowl the most pins over their average. Teams in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in their division will receive plaques.

JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT

In April of 2012 Wickliffe Lanes will also be holding our Junior Scholarship Tournament in which bowlers can win scholarship money. This will be a handicap tournament with bowlers competing in their perspective age divisions. All Scholarship money will be awarded into the USBC Smart program.
